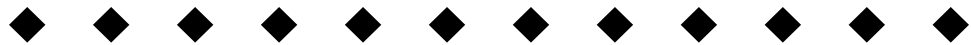
Family Literacy Fun Day

As of August 2011 she has published 54 novels, most under the Anna Jacobs name with a few written under two different names - Shannah Jay (SF/F), Sherry -Anne Jacobs (non-fiction and one historical romance).

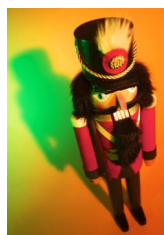
