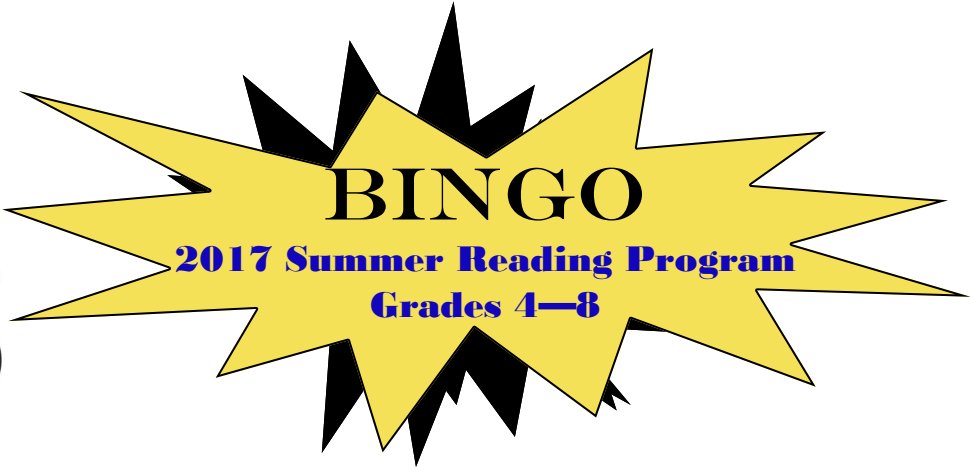

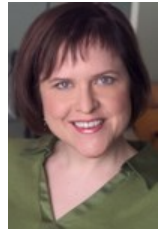


CREATIVE WRITING CLUB - Tuesdays and Thursdays, July 11-July 27, 1:00pm-3:00pm

SKYPE WITH MARYROSE WOOD Monday, July 10, 2:00pm-3:00pm

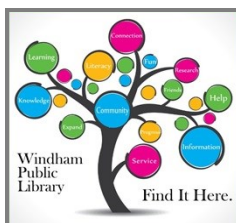
