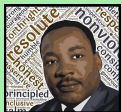

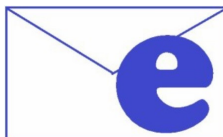

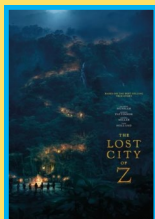

Not Getting Your Email Notifications from us?

In some cases, this may be due to the notice having been perceived as junk by your e-mail program, partly because the Minerva system sends out so many of these notices at once. A proactive way to make sure this doesn't happen is to let your e-mail program know that you really do want to receive e-mails from the library's automated system. Construction has started in what will be the new Children's Room and the new Circulation area. The construction is still in the demolition phase. When that's over, there will be electrical work, plumbing, the building of walls, and the creation of a new Circulation desk.



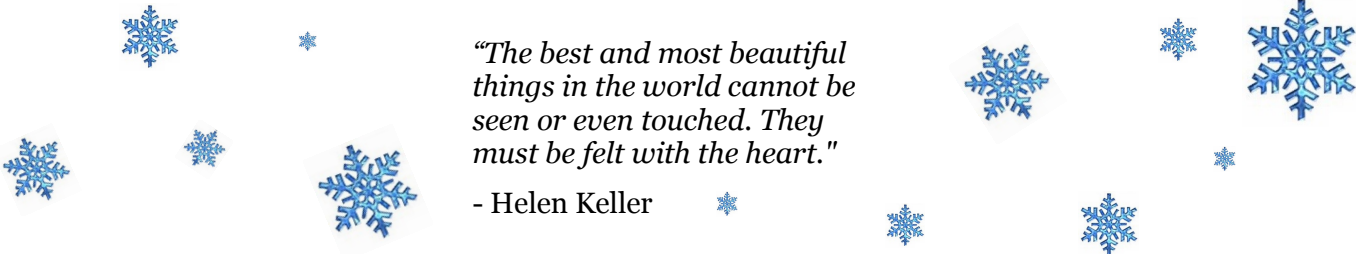
Director Jen Alvino notes that "the temporary children's space, although significantly smaller than the space patrons are used to, is very cozy." She adds, "We've been **able to continue Books and Babies and Story Time.**" Also, our most popularly circulating items are still available. Other items are, as always, available through Minerva.

The Library will remain open as much as possible and we will announce any upcoming closures as soon as we know about them. Alvino says that we are hopefully looking at a completion date sometime in the early spring. In addition to the construction, other exciting things are happening at the library. We now offer **self-service learning opportunities through Universal Class.** With more than five hundred online classes (some video, some more like a PowerPoint presentation)—including yoga, dog training, bookkeeping, Excel, and cake decorating, just to name a few—Alvino says that "if you're looking for something to learn, chances are it'll be here."

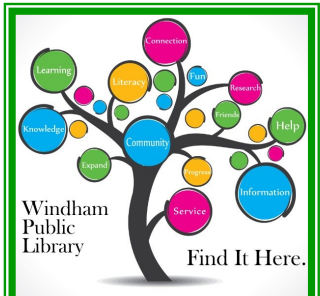



Alvino says that when she's looking at new services for the library, she's looking at what can give her "the most bang for her buck." And Universal Class provides a huge value for the cost. Alvino points to "the broad range of subjects and the amount of learning" available through this service. She notes that, for the price, we would "never be able to provide all that in print." 
