Registration – Borrowing privileges are free to anyone who lives, works, or goes to school in Windham. Non-residents may pay \$25 annually for a membership.

You may also return your library items in the drop box located next to the main entrance even when we are closed. Library Services

Passes – Call the library for availability of passes to local museums, parks, and other attractions.



Meeting Room & Study Rooms– Reserve our public meeting room for local educational, civic, and cultural groups. Study rooms available for tutoring, test-taking, and quiet meetings. Please check with us for information and availability.

Computers – Free access for anyone. Internet and basic word processing programs. One hour time limit (extended if no one waiting) as availability allows. Printing: black/white, \$.10 per page; color, \$.25. Wireless printing and Wi-Fi also available.
