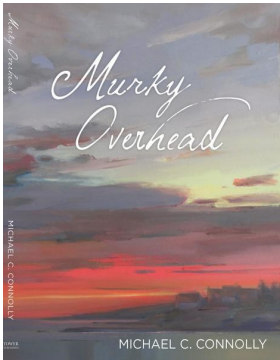

Wednesday, July 26th, 6-7pm**

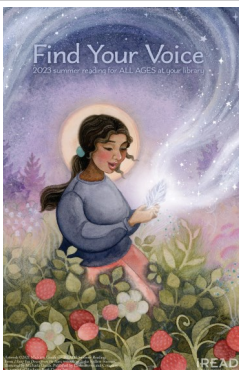

A high school senior struggling with social anxiety disorder goes on a journey of self-discovery in the wake of a fellow student's suicide.

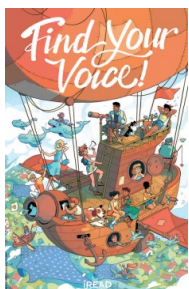


Bill Berlinghoff—Folk Music Concert (Choice) Wednesday, August 16th, 6-7pm
