



Emerging Readers Build Your Character Sheet Instructions

Emerging readers will enjoy developing a character as much as a reader will, but will likely need assistance in completing their character sheet from choosing quotes or ideas to filling in the character sheet. Young children may want to use the Full Character sheet as their family and

friends, or you may help them use this simplified version.

Please note the changes below.

Character Name & What I Look Like

Same as the Full Character: at any time, Emergent readers can add or change their Character's name or What I Look Like drawing.

Overall Level

This is omitted for Emerging Readers. When taking on a challenge, they will use the level of the specific Ability they chose: Strength, Smarts, or Power Boost.

Categories and Abilities

The Emergent Reader Character Sheet Abilities combine the original Categories and Abilities into three easy to understand categories. They will add their quotes to the Ability itself.

- Strength: ★ for Physical
- Smarts: ● Mental & ■ Learned
- Power Boost: How I Help Others: ♥ Charm & ▲ Extraordinary.

Ability Level Increases

The Ability level for Emergent readers is equal to the number of quotes they have per ability.

Remember, have fun interpreting quotes to develop a character's abilities!
